NetSuite Makes Exec Appointments in Japan and Europe

Cloud computing business management software provider NetSuite has appointed Hajime Tamura as president of NetSuite KK in Japan, and Steve Sydes as managing director of NetSuite EMEA.

Tamura joined NetSuite KK from SAP Japan, where he was vice president of its customer innovation center and vice president of marketing. Before joining SAP he managed the Japanese subsidiary of Glovia International. He also held sales and management positions at JD Edwards, Baan, and Otsuka Corp.

Sydes has joined NetSuite EMEA from Acal in the UK where he was managing director and a member of the board of directors. Before that he was he at Advanced Crystal Technology, Gothic Crellon, and GEC Computers.

In the second quarter 2009 NetSuite reported a net loss of \$5.17m compared to a loss of \$3.53m in the year-ago quarter, on revenue up 10% at \$40.3m.
